WHY?

To meet people

To speak French

VOLUNTEERING

WHAT?

A free action, done freely, by desire, solidarity or conviction.



FREE AND COMMITTED!

You can stop your volunteering work any time you want, but do not forget that the association counts on you. Please advise them in advance!



WHERE?

In a non-commercial organisation: association, commune, public hospital, sports club, school...

ARE PAPERS NEEDED?

You can work as a volunteer in Belgium if:

- your presence is covered by a residence permit or document
- you are an asylum-seeker or an Unaccompanied Foreign Minor

AM I BEING PAID?

No. Volunteering is not a job.

DO I NEED TO SPEAK FRENCH WELL?

Sometimes yes. Sometimes no. It depends on the volunteering activity.

If you don't speak French fluently, it is however possible to work as a volunteer with someone speaking your language, or in a group.

ARE MY FEES REIMBURSED?

The organisation can choose to pay back your fees (Bus, lunch,...) but it is not forced to do so.

AM I BEING COVERED BY AN INSURANCE?

The organisation must insure you in civil liability. The insurance will therefore pay for damages caused to others while you work as a volunteer.
