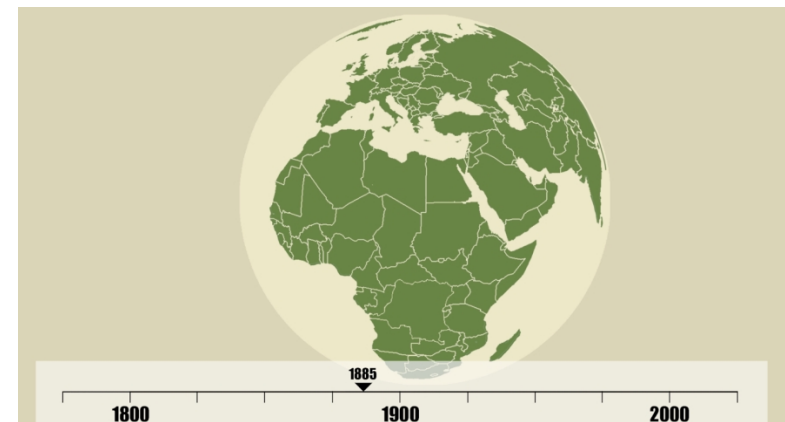

- Member of the European Union

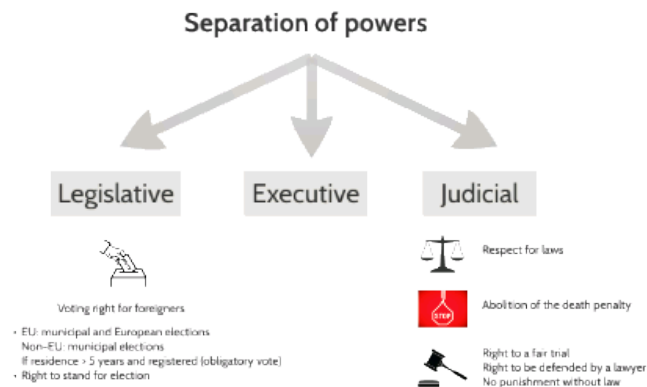


Belgian Constitution

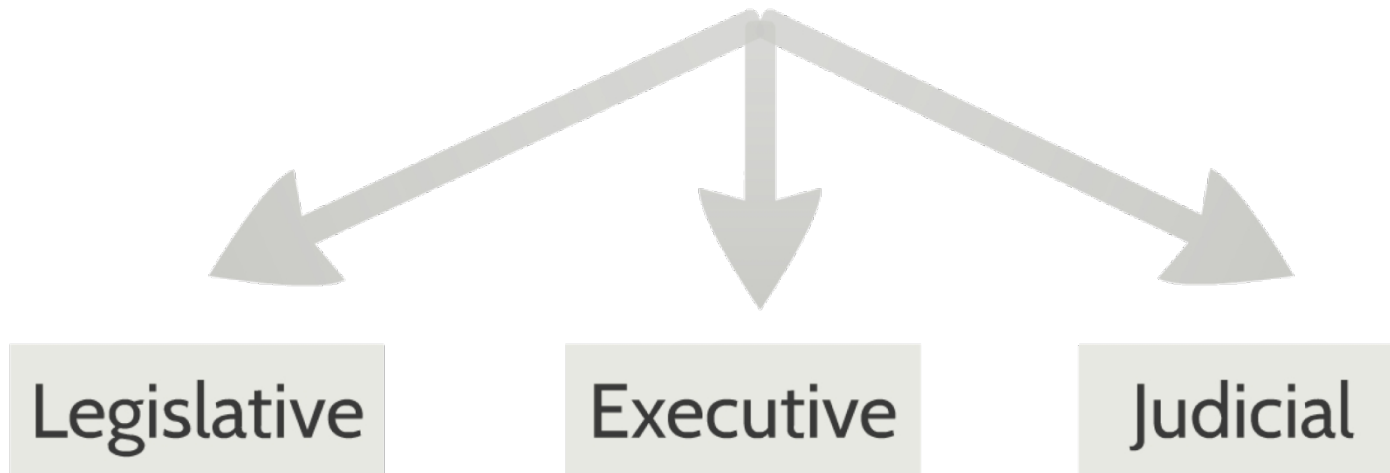


- Democratic rule of law
 - = laws and rules apply to EVERYBODY in the same way
 - = separation of powers

Separation of powers



Voting right for foreigners

- EU: municipal and European elections
Non-EU: municipal elections
If residence > 5 years and registered (obligatory vote)
- Right to stand for election



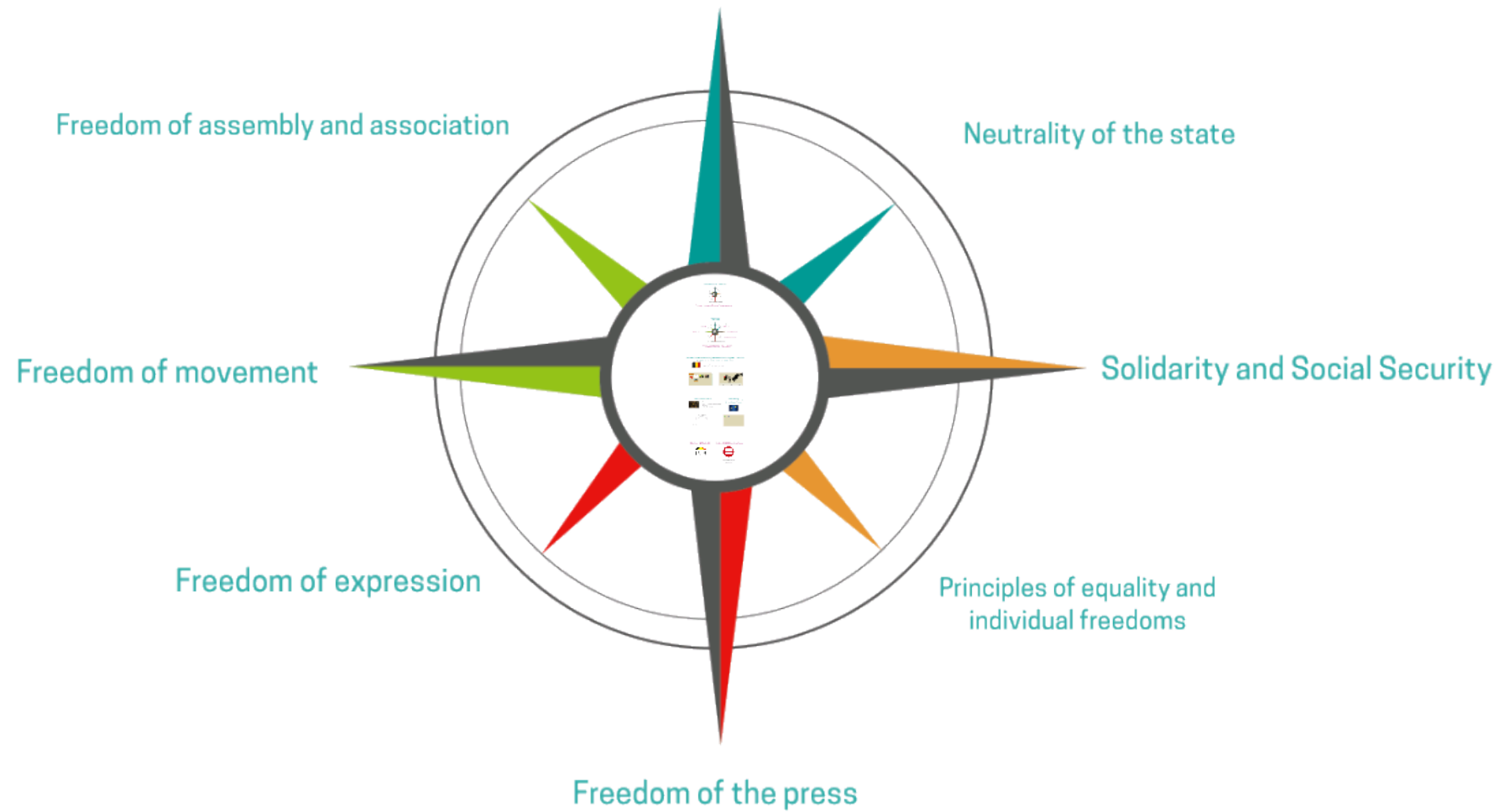
Respect for laws
